

# Diamond Bar Girls Softball All Star Interest / Commitment Notification

To DBGS Parents, Players, Managers and Coaches:

Diamond Bar Girls Softball has a selection process to select one All Star team per division. This letter explains the commitment involved should your daughter be selected to an All Star team.

The purpose of this letter is for you to notify the league that you are interested in placing your daughter onto the list of players who are eligible to be nominated for the All Star team. **Parents who are interested in placing their daughter onto the list of eligible players to be nominated to the All Star Team must sign this letter and return it to their coach AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, but no later than Monday, April 21, 2011.**

***This is not a selection letter.*** Selection to the All-Star team will require commitment from both the player and their parents. It is an honor to be selected to represent your peers and the league, and only a small percentage of players are chosen. Players and parents must declare a commitment for all practices and games, beginning approximately the third week of May through at least July 13.

Any player who has also participated with a travel team **after March 31, 2011 is not eligible** for all-stars per ASA rule (Participation includes: a practice with; play a game with; or more than one tryout with any travel team, ASA or non-ASA).

The All-Star teams will play a minimum of 3 tournaments in May/June/July. Practices could be 3-5 days a week. Tournament dates are:

Tournament play involves a varying schedule that could, and often takes up the entire weekend. Most tournaments have a three game minimum with more games if the team advances. It is not unusual for tournament schedules to be posted just days before the games and pool play games are usually Friday and Saturdays. If teams advance, they then play Saturday and Sunday. There may be back to back games or their could be five or six hour gaps between games.

All Star teams are competitive teams and the "fair play" rule does not apply. Managers will place the girls as he/she feels best benefits the team. It is possible that your daughter may not play in a game or tournament. Parents are asked to set a positive atmosphere with strong support for the team managers, coaches, players, and parents. Parents agree to abide by the DBGS Code of Conduct.

## Monetary Commitment:

If your child is chosen as an All Star, there is a \$140.00 per player fee.(\$110 6U) All Stars is an extended season and most teams will play more games during the 'All Star season' than the entire Spring season. The league will pay for a total of 4 tournaments (including DBGS tournament). If a team advances beyond the district tournament, the league will pay the registration fee for the state tournament. The league does not provide fees for "second chance" tournaments.

Each player will receive one complete uniform including shirt, shorts, socks and visor. Managers may also request that parents purchase compression shorts and/or sliding pads to match the All Star uniform. Helmets and bat bags are the responsibility of the parent and will be provided by an outside supplier.

Diamond Bar hosts a tournament. Our tournament brings teams from all over Southern California. All Diamond Bar teams participate in the tournament. Every All Star parent is required to volunteer their time during the weekend. Parents will help with preparation, set up, clean up, and snack bar duties as required.

If your child is selected for an All Star team, you will be asked to sign a commitment agreement.
