- III. Public Comment:
 - a. Concerns about whether we will be a “B” or “C” league come All Stars. Gloria has been in constant communication with Ralph, our district rep, about the issue. They are saying it is looking like we will be bumping back down to C’s this year due to not performing well in B’s last year in all divisions.

- VI. Pitching Clinics 8s and 10s

 - c. Once we have a pitching coach, Randy said he would host catchers clinics during the same time as pitching clinics to give girls opportunities on both sides of the mound.

- VIII. City Issues:
 - a. We were initially told that we would be able to have a second bin but are not being told we are only able to have one bin, which currently is our one bin at the top of Pantera. We need to continue to fight and come to a compromise with the city. For now we will have to continue to store the most used equipment (bases, broom, chalk, rake, etc) in the snack bar. As it currently stands the city has denied ALL requests we have made to get a bin down closer to the fields.
 - b. There will be a City Council meeting on March 19. Gloria has volunteered to represent the league to bring up the issue during their public comment portion of the meeting. We need a volunteer to represent us in April and again in May. We need to be at these meetings every month until our issue has been resolved.
 - c. The city decides field allocations are based on what percentage of participants in the league are Diamond Bar residence. They reserve the right to charge the league for field usage if we fall under 40%. We currently stand at 38%.

1. Bob will talk to Councilman Andrew Chou about the bin and DB residence issue. He plans to point out that we are not only serving Diamond Bar, but its surrounding cities. The city doesn't seem to support our league and being able to maintain 40% without the city attempt to support us is unfair and unrealistic.
