

## CODE OF CONDUCT

It is important for all involved with Diamond Bar Girls' Softball League to understand that the program is in existence to service the youth of our communities. The conduct of all managers, coaches, players and parents must be beyond reproach to support this program. Listed below are policies established by the Diamond Bar Girls' Softball Board of Directors relating to field decorum and safety.

### PLAYER CONDUCT:

- A.** Each player is under direct supervision of her Manager/Coach and must obey the same.
- B.** Un-sports person like conduct, which may include vulgarity, vulgar gestures, physical attack or abusing equipment, will not be permitted.
- C.** During the game players shall remain on the field or bench except, with the Manager/Coach's permission, to get a drink or go to the restroom. Non-players shall not be permitted to sit on the bench or be on the field during the game.
- D.** All players must respect the school/ city property where practices and games are held.
- E.** The appearance on the field by a player in an intoxicated condition or consuming alcoholic beverages will not be permitted.

### ADULTS RESPONSIBILITY:

- A.** Managers, Coaches, or Parents may not participate or attend a game or practice in an intoxicated condition or consume alcoholic beverages.
- B.** No Manager/ Coach may leave a player unattended after a team function.
- C.** Managers, Coaches, or Parents can best demonstrate sportsperson like conduct by example. The practice of booing, criticizing the league, bad language or disagreeing with the umpire will only destroy the game and may not be permitted.

In the event that a Manager, Coach, Player or Parent elects not to follow the policies listed above, the person in question may be asked to leave the league pending a Board of Directors / Protest Committee review.
