

Junior Umpire Program for 2011

DBGS will reimburse new Junior Umpires (JU) for their initial ASA Shirt, ball bag, ball & strike indicator, brush, and mask. (For 2011: A set amount will be established prior to the Rules Clinic) DBGS will reimburse for the Mechanics clinic and equipment after the following have been completed and/or complied with:

- A) Be between the ages of 14 thru 17 years old.**
- B) Attend the required Umpire Mechanics clinic offered by ASA.**
- C) Completion of 4 games for which you will be paid.**
- D) Receipts for the equipment and clinic, are mandatory for reimbursement.**

All returning JU's must also attend the Mechanic's Clinic. Equipment or upgrade to equipment will be borne by the JU. For reimbursements you must show evidence:

- A) Of attendance to the Umpire Mechanics clinic offered by ASA.**
- B) If a returning JU's wants to move up to be certified you will be reimbursed for the Rules Clinic upon passing the ASA Umpires test.**
- C) Receipts for all clinics and a print out of the passing of the Umpire Test with score are mandatory for reimbursement.**

ALL PERSONS APPLYING FOR THIS PROGRAM WILL BE APPROVED PRIOR TO ATTENDING ANY CLASSES. IF NO APPROVAL IS RECEIVED ALL COSTS WILL BE BORNE BY THE INDIVIDUAL.

First year JU's will be limited to U8 games only and will be paid \$25.00 per game. The rate will remain the same for U10 games if for scheduling reasons no U8 Games are available.

Returning JU's will umpire U10 games and be paid \$30.00 per game. The only reason you would umpire a U8 game would be to fill the schedule if there are not enough first year JUs.

There will also be games available for the DBGS All Star Tournament and the Fall seasons.

There are limited openings so please submit to me, your Junior Umpire applications ASAP.
